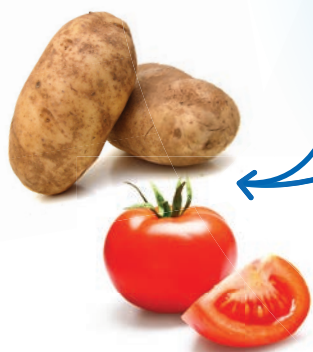
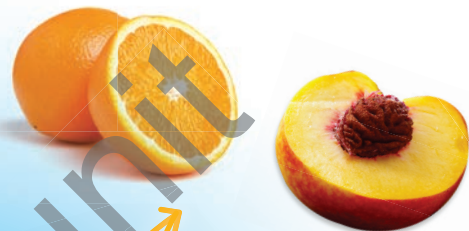
## The origin of fruits and vegetables

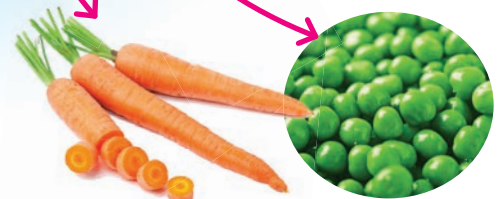

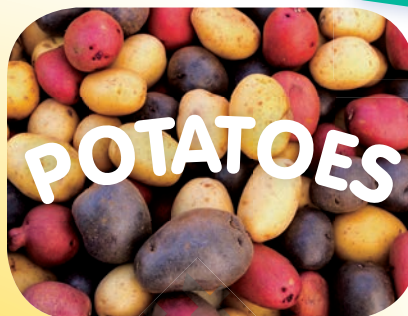
